

Story Planners

Sometimes children need structure for their story writing. Younger children who are just beginning to write and older children who have difficulties in organising their writing (or indeed with writing) would benefit from using a story planner.

I have included one below. Alternatively you could divide a piece of A4 paper into 6 boxes.

Turn the paper so that it is landscape and in each box write;

1. Who?
2. Where?
3. When?
4. What happened first?
5. What happened next?
6. How did it end?

The children can then draw a picture in the larger box and use the smaller box below to write in
